## THIS DANCE that is the KABUKI

I am an enthusiast of music and low and with rare exceptions all out actual performances. I would close with an expression of the hope that occidental dance experts will come to study with minute care the fine points of the Japanese dance. The aesthetic pleasure to be derived from such a study would well repay their efforts.

—Jiro Tsuji, in Contemporary Japan

First-class Kabuki players are men. In the case of the dance, there are a few famous danseuses but they perform both male and female parts. Similarly, famous actors frequently play feminine roles and their fame depends on their being more womanly in their acting than women. Such being the case, it must be admitted that the technique of the Japanese dance is among the most difficult in the world.

A Kabuki actor, of course, does not merely play a feminine role in one play, but also plays the fierce and heroic warrior immediately after assuming the part of a tender princess. He must be able to dance these different parts with equal skill and in this respect I think that the Japanese Kabuki dancer has few equals in the world. That almost all famous dancers are also first class actors is because Japanese dancing requires a great deal of dramatic talent, I believe.

Another outstanding feature of Kabuki dancing technique is the way in which the hands and arms are trained to suggest statically certain actions. Kikugoro himself has a score of such evocative poses, the most famous of which is perhaps his catching of a butterfly. Again, it must be stressed that the art lies not in the realistic performance of a gesture but in the striking of a pose that evokes the gesture in the mind's eye and, because of its static quality, impresses the mind with a clear memory.

There are some other points that I should like to dwell upon, but they would be difficult to explain without the aid of pictures.

The first difference that strikes me in comparing Japanese and western dancing is that while western dancing tries to show movement the Japanese dance seeks to portray it. It may seem strange to say that dancing endeavors to depict "rest" and, no doubt, I would not lack opponents of this theory even among Japanese.

Japanese dance is compared with occidental dancing I think that I am justified in my contention, even if it may not be entirely free from exaggeration. The Japanese dance, in a word, seeks to display a beautiful figure at rest. As many such figures are shown in a dance piece, the movements ought to be considered merely as a means of transition from one figure to another. Consequently, the figures at rest are the essential part of the Japanese dance. For example, one is repeatedly conscious of such posed figures. An occasional dancing seeks to show beauty of motion, I think that there are almost no figures at rest.

This difference, I believe, is a most fundamental and essential one without the cognizance of which all the other grounds of comparison must become invalid. It is because of this factor that Japanese dancing seems slow in tempo, but familiarity with it will show, I think, that the subtle flavor that Japanese dance, despite its slow tempo, lies in these figures at rest.

One major difference between the two modes of dancing in respect of performance is that in Japanese Kabuki male and female roles are not necessarily performed by men and women respectively. This holds true for the Kabuki drama as a whole. The status of actresses in the Kabuki school of the drama is quite
