My dear Holway:

I have heard from Berth, and he gives me a satisfactory account of the situation at Fort Bragg. It seems he has left the place and is in another part of California, so that my letter was delayed in reaching him.

I also have your letter regarding the intensity sections and should have acknowledged its receipt before. In one of your letters you mentioned Westport, north of Fort Bragg. I am very shy of information as to the section of the coast in that vicinity, upon which to base any judgment as to the intensity of the earthquake. Eakle came down from Kenny to Fort Bragg, but practically got no information. If you have any notes as to the destructive effects of the earthquake at any of those points north of Fort Bragg, I would be very glad if you would place them at my disposal.
