Dear Sir:

Your favor of May 27th, enclosing a blue print map of San Francisco, with the scheme for the distribution of the pipes for the fire protection system of the city, came to hand yesterday. I have thus far had time only to glance at the map, and will take the matter up in a few days and advise you further regarding the question of the probable immunity of the proposed pipe lines to earthquake shock. I may have one or two suggestions to make when I have a little time to compare your map with my intensity and geological maps of the city, proofs of which I hope to get from the engraver this week. I unfortunately do not have even the originals at hand, so that I may be a few days in answering your letter in full.
