Dear Sir:

Your letter of May 18 has been forwarded to me here from Berkeley, and in reply I regret to say that there is no elementary text on the geology of California. I suggest that you look over the list of the bulletins of the Department of Geology of the University of California, Berkeley, Cal., which you can obtain by applying to the University Press, and you will find there certain literature which may be useful to you. I also suggest your getting the folios of the U.S. Geological Survey dealing with the geology of California.

As to your inquiry regarding the best explanation of the San Francisco earthquake, I can only say that it is not yet published. The Commission has in preparation a somewhat detailed account of the earthquake which will go to press this summer. You may be interested, however, in referring to the preliminary report on the earthquake, which may be had of the Secretary of the Commission, Professor A. O. Leuschner, Berkeley, Cal., upon application.
