Subject: Potential Employees in the Poston Two Garnishing Sheds

After a check through the records in our camp, we are submitting the following information regarding the number of American citizens over eighteen years of age residing in Poston Two:

American citizens over 18	1368	737	631
American citizens over 18 who are working	<u>1104*</u>	<u>696</u>	<u>408</u>
Available	264**	41	223

\*Of the number who are working, 443 are working in the Kitchens, 289 of whom are dishwashers, waiters, and other kitchen help and could be easily replaced.

\*\*Of the 264 you will note that 223 are women, a great number of whom are young mothers and probably would not be available for fulltime work.

It is therefore estimated that there will be approximately 400 American citizens over eighteen years of age who would be available for work in these garnishing sheds.
