SUBJECT: Change in 35%

Last night in the block 13 messhall the Council met in a special session to devise a method of splitting the camouflage income. The committee is meeting today to propound several plans, which will be decided by Council and then turned over to the people for a general election to select the popular plan.

In addition, the camouflage outfit was there to present their case on the 35% ruling which was passed Saturday. The Council reversed themselves but recommending that the present quota of 13,200 nets, 12 x 12 in size, be garnished with the workers retaining all of the income other than subsistence and taxes.
