

[Sugiyama's memo to Stahl]

Feb. 17, 1943 Memorandum to Mr. John Stahl 2035 Bay Street Los Angeles, California Mr. Rosenbloom Camouflage Factory

This letter will authorize you to make payments to the camouflage workers on the following basis: After deductions for subsistence, victory tax, social security, and other expenses are subtracted, you are to pay the individual worker 65% of the net proceeds. The remaining 35% of the workers' wages are to be paid to the community council by certified check.

The above mentioned division of the workers' wages was presented in a regularly held assemblage of the councilmen. It was unanimously approved.

Roy Nakadegawa, 35-5-C, a weaver, is leaving this project immediately to go outside. I understand that he will leave tomorrow evening. Will you kindly see to it that his wages reach him before he leaves?
