**MINUTES OF MEETING OF TEMPORARY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Temporary chairman and secretary were elected: Chairman, Harry Kumagai; secretary, George Kubo.

The following motion was moved, seconded and carried:

THAT THE COMMITTEE NEGOTIATE WITH MR. BILICKE, PRODUCTION MANAGER, TO CHANGE THE WORK WEEK SCHEDULE AS FOLLOWS SO THAT THE WORKERS MAY HAVE TIME TO TAKE CARE OF PERSONAL AND BUSINESS AFFAIRS ON FRIDAY AFTERNOONS: 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM Monday thru Thursday and 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM Friday and Saturday.

All members agreed that the above work schedule shall be strictly observed by all employees (when approved by the management). It was further pointed out that the workers are bound by contract agreement to put in 40 hours per week whether working in the non-productive departments or in the weaving department. Piece work, being a method of payment, does not permit a worker to leave before regular quitting time.

The contents of the Notice to All Workers, as resolved by the general meeting, was prepared and a copy of the Notice is attached hereto.
