### **PORPOSALS OF THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMPENSATION OF THE CAMOUFLAGE NET MANUFACTURING**

1. Whole amount earned by each worker to be paid to his after deducting \$25 per month for the subsistence.
2. Set quota as 6 workers to each 100 in a block, or give preference of work for those Niseis from each family who are under the following categories:
  - (a) No one working in a family with two or more dependants.
  - (b) One working with three or more dependants.
  - (c) Two working with five or more dependants.
3. The employables in the Camouflage Net Manufacturing Plant are those Niseis of High School graduate.
4. Workers to be revolved on a monthly basis.
5. Donate 10 per cent of the net earnings to the needy families within the block. Those needy families are defined as those families with three or more members and none of them are employable.
