MEMORANDUM TO: Manager of the Camouflage Factory

SUBJECT: Arizona State Law

I am quoting you from Arizona Code 56-320, hours of labor from female for the certain occupations - posting:

Every employer shall post in a conspicuous place in every room where females are employed, a printed notice stating the hours of commencing and stopping work, the time allowed for meals and the maximum number of hours any female employee is permitted to work in any one day, and the employment of any female at any time other than in conformity with the posted hours of labor shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.
