Gentlemen:

An inspection of the Camouflage Net Factory made at 9:50 A.M. this date disclosed that the fire prevention instructions outlined in my letter of February 26, of which a copy is attached, are not being complied with.

During this inspection I noted that one of the hose reels was empty. Upon inquiry, I was told by one of the employees that this hose had been loaned by Mr. Finney to the Allied Contractors at Blythe.

This is final notice that unless the fire protection procedure outlined in the letter of February 26 is immediately complied with, it will be necessary for me to inform the office of the War Relocation Authority of the fire hazard existing and the lack of cooperation on your part.
