Dear Mr. Stahl:

The question of whether or not subsistence for workers on the part-time night shift should be deducted is now pending the decision of Mr. Myer in Washington. We have requested that Mr. Myer make no subsistence deduction for the part-time night workers.

Until we have received his answer, will you please deduct the regular subsistence from the night workers' wages and hold this sum in trust until such time as Mr. Myer has made a definite decision the matter.
