NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that for and in consideration of the foregoing and the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by the Government, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I by these presents, do sell, assign, and transfer unto the Government, as represented by the Secretary of War and his successors in office, the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention and in and to any and all Letters Patent wherever they may be granted thereon, as well as reissues and extensions of said Letters Patent, the same to be held and enjoyed by the said Government of the United States, to the full end of the term or terms for which Letters Patent are or may be granted, reissued, or extended, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held or enjoyed by me had this
