Board action last Friday should meet Mario Giannini criticism and he should withdraw his resignation. In view of big benefactions of Giannini family and great potential service his loss to Board would be serious. May I suggest you wire him fast message today at Statler Hotel, Washington, D. C., urging him to withdraw his resignation immediately and join the rest of us in trying to work out the many problems confronting the University.
