Memorandum to Paul A. Dodd from the Office of the President, July 24, 1950

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July 24, 1950

DEAN DODD:

Replying to your telegram, I give you the following information with reference to the non-signers who were cleared last Friday. Since the June 23 meeting, twenty of the one hundred fifty seven who failed through negligence or otherwise to meet the Regent's requirements, have resigned and their resignations have been accepted. Thirty-one have now complied with the requirement of the Regents, and made a categorical statement that they are not members of the Communist Party. Two have been found not to have received appointment letters, twenty-one to have had late hearings, and action has been deferred in these cases pending an opportunity for them to qualify. The Regents have ruled that the following personnel on the Los Angeles campus are no longer in the employ of the University:
