



Memorandum to Clarence A. Dykstra from Robert G. Sproul, July 13, 1949

VICE PRESIDENT DYESTRA:

On June 21, you reported to me that Deans Rhulman and Hahn had concurred in approval of Regulation #17 as most recently revised, but had raised a question as to whether, under its terms, permission might be granted for members of the Communist Party to speak on the campus under any conditions.

In view of the Regents' policy on the Communist Party, now twice reaffirmed, I have no hesitation in ruling that a member of the Communist Party is not to be permitted to use the facilities of the University, otherwise than as a student, under any conditions whatsoever.
