The Merrymount Press Artifacts Collection.

The Bancroft Library of the University of California at Berkeley has a large book artifacts collection that illustrates the development of writing and the history of printing as well as the practice of the various book arts. The collection, generally known by the acronym BART is fully recorded in a register and index shelved at the Reference Desk in the Heller Reading Room of The Bancroft Library; it is briefly described and summarized in <u>A Guide to the Book Artifacts Collection</u>, published in 1985.

Since 1985, much new material has been acquired and added to the register. (The Guide has not been revised.) Among the most interesting additions are the more than 750 wood engravings, electrotypes, photoengravings, brass binding dies and typecast ornaments, formerly the property of The Merrymount Press, and given in 1985 by Daniel Berkeley Bianchi, son of the late John Bianchi, a partner in the Press from 1915. (Previously, Mr. D.B. Bianchi had donated all the typecast ornamental materials and some of the historic types collected and used by Daniel Berkeley Updike from the opening of the Press in 1893 until its closure by John Bianchi in 1949.)

Upon its arrival at The Bancroft Library, the collection was counted, sorted and classified in the BART scheme. (Numberings used at The Merrymount Press were retained.) Basic decisions followed: first, to proof each item on the Super Royal Albion handpress in The Bancroft Library's Press Room so that a maximum control of pressure was possible in order to protect the valuable artifacts; second, a decision to make the best possible proofs for reference and classification rather than to spend time trying for reproduction-quality proofs; third, a special woodcut black ink would be used with high-quality reproduction-proof paper, donated through the good offices of Harry Summerfield, to achieve the best possible results under the adopted guidelines.

Hardly any item in the collection, except the typecast materials, was exactly type high. Each piece was gauged and proper steps taken to adjust the impression to gain the best possible image without jeopardizing the artifact. Several very old woodcuts were very much over type high and are the least satisfactory in the proofing although readily identifiable. Wood-mounted photoengravings had shrunk through the years and often the nails holding them in place printed as well as the image. All these variations had to be accommodated while there was a time limit on the availability of the Albion Press which was also being used for a class.

Many electrotypes were not mounted for it was the practice of The Merrymount Press to have individual pieces electrotyped at one time and then to cut out and mount in-house those items that were needed for work at hand. Much typecast material and many wood engravings were prepared in this manner in order to obtain exact duplicates of scarce items. The binding dies were never intended to be mounted. In short, improvisation without concern for achieving a definitive image governed the proofing. Three proofs were pulled of each individual item.

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In a ledger held by The Huntington Library there is the following entry: "Boston, January 1915. ...January 1 Partnership formed this date taking over the property of The Merrymount Press except for the following:.. 9....old wood blocks (Bewick and others)." Many of these were included in the Bianchi gift and are reproduced here.

After the proofs had been completed, one set became a working copy in the search for sources of the originals and the specific uses Updike made of them. The need to consult a complete collection of Merrymount Press imprints was quickly evident. We therefore applied to The Huntington Library and were awarded a Fellowship in time for us to take up residence for the month of January 1988. We had a most rewarding experience and the staff cooperation was exemplary. We are especially grateful to Virginia Renner, Mary Robertson, Allan Jutzi, Mary Wright, Fred Perez, Lida Bushloper and their assistants who most patiently brought the very large quantities of letters, books and business records to the reading room where we were assigned a special, sound-proof carrel so we would not disturb others.

Our goals at The Huntington were threefold: first, to identify the artist or source of wood engravings which were not identifiable as Bewicks; second, to identify and find an earlier use of the Bewick wood engravings; third, to identify and record at least one use of each of the artifacts by The Merrymount Press. Many of the non-Bewick blocks remain unidentified in any way. We hope scholars may eventually be able to do so. Determining Merrymount Press usage was often impossible, probably because some artifacts never appeared in actual publications. Others may have been used in ephemera not included in the collections at The Bancroft, The Huntington or the Providence Public Library which were surveyed.

The final product of our work, which follows, was achieved by cutting up one set of proofs, pasting each individual item on its descriptive catalog sheet and finally printing two copies of each on a Kodak Ectaprint 100 copying machine to achieve the best possible transfer of image and data.
