



IN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

Be it Remembered, that on this twenty sixth day of February, Anno Domini One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-Three, before the Commissioners to ascertain and settle the Private Land Claims in the State of California, sitting as a Board in the City of San Francisco, in the State aforesaid, in the United States of America, the following Proceedings were had, to wit;

The Petition of The City of Sonora, for the Place named One sq: mile of City land, was presented, and ordered to be filed and docketed with No. 639 and is as follows, to wit;

Upon which Petition the following subsequent Proceedings were had in their chronological order, to wit;

San Francisco December 5th 1854,
Case no. 639, City of Sonora for City Lands, was ordered to be placed at the foot of the 3d Class cases on the Trial Docket.

San Francisco December 19th 1854,
Case no. 639 was submitted under the Rule of March 21st 1854.

San Francisco Jan. 23rd 1855.
In the same case Commissioner R. A. Thompson delivered the opinion of the Board rejecting the claim;

To the Honorable

The Board of Commissioners
to Settle the Claims to Land in the State
of California under an act of the Congress
of the United States of America Entitled
An act to ascertain and settle the private
Land Claims in the State of California
which act was approved on the thirteenth
day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and fifty one

Your petitioner the Mag-
or and Common Council of the City of Sonora
a Corporate and Municipal body Settled
in the County of Tuolumne in said
State respectfully represent and show that
On or about the first day of October A.D.
1849, the citizens of said County then
residing on the hill of San Joaquin
Embraced within the corporate limits, then
consisting of several thousand inhabitants
lands for the better security of person and
property and to insure the administration
of Justice established a Town and chose
there a Town Council in the government
thereof which Town Council was duly
organized, and at a meeting thereof
held on the 8th day of October A.D.
1849, the said Town Council by a vote
thereof defined the limits thereof to be
One Mile Square - the center being the
"Grove" at the junction of Main Street
in said Town, the name of which street
was afterwards by the adoption of a
Survey of Lots in said Town made by
One W. J. Cooper in March A.D. 1850
changed to Washington Street and is
now known by that name and now
goes by the name "Grove" which "Anyo" is
known as the "Anyo" de Sonora

And your petitioner
respectfully represent and show that on
the first day of May A.D. 1851 the said
Town of Sonora was by an Act of the
Legislature of California Entitled "An

Act to incorporate the City of Sonora
incorporated into a City, under the Corporate
Name and Style of "The Mayor and Common
Council of the City of Sonora and the
Corporate Limits of said City are the
Same as the limits of the Town of Sonora
as established by the said Town Council
as aforesaid and are by the Second Section
of said act of incorporation defined
to be all that certain piece or parcel of
Land being One mile Square Selected
near the headwaters of Woods' Creek
in the County of Tuolumne and State
of California, within the following bounds
viz Commencing at a point One half mile
due East of the centre of the "Anaya de
Sonora" and Washington Street in the City
of Sonora where said Street crosses said
"Aroya", running thence North One half
mile - thence West One mile - thence
South One mile - thence East One mile
and thence North One half mile to the
place of Beginning; and was a Town
before under the name of the parish and
approval of the aforesaid Act of Congress

Wherefore in consideration of the
aforementioned petitioners pray that the said
lands embraced within the corporate
limits aforesaid be by you Surveyed
Board, under the provisions of the said
Act of Congress, confirmed to the said
"The Mayor and Common Council of the
City of Sonora" and their successors and
assigns.

of the same be denied.



to the Attorney General of the United States




