



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Be it Remembered, that on this second day of March, Anno Domini One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-three, before the Commissioners to ascertain and settle the Private Land Claims in the State of California, sitting as a Board in the City of San Francisco, in the State aforesaid, in the United States of America, the following Proceedings were had, to wit;

The Petition of Frances J. White, for the place named lands in Sacramento County was presented, and ordered to be filed and docketed with No. 776 and is as follows, to wit;

Upon which Petition the following subsequent Proceedings were had in their chronological order, to wit;

San Francisco January 9th 1855.
Case no. 776, Frances J. White for lands in Sacramento County, was ordered to be placed at the foot of the 4th class cases on the Trial Docket.

San Francisco January 23rd 1855.
Case no. 776, was submitted under the Rule of March 21st 1854.

San Francisco April 14th 1855.
In the same case Commissioner S. B. Farwell delivered the Opinion of the Board rejecting the claim:

State of California ³ Petition to the Honorable Board
San Francisco City of Sacramento setting aside
court for the Justification and adjudication of
land claim of the City of Sacramento & State
fully knows before the Honorable Board that he is a
resident of the City of San Francisco & State
affirms that the claim or claims to certain tracts
various described herein by virtue of our
original survey cannot be less than one hundred and


