May name is Peter Quivry. I was Im in the State of New York. I came to California in the year 1846, and to the "Pueble de San Joe" in September 1847, and have continued to reside here since that time. May age is 48 years.

I know the track of land situated east of the Coyota, about four miles from San Jose - called the "Rancho de Pala!" in the County of Santa Clara, have Known it for the last eight years. It's boundaries were pointed out to me many years since by several old residents. The South West corner was at a stump, marked with a cross-one of a grove of oak trick and stood about two hundred jards from the old house of anistacio Chabayi. From thence the South line - dending the "Tala" from "Yeba Bewina", or Chalogo's Rancho- nen easterly to an oak tree, also marked with a cross, which stands at the boot of the hills, this was known as the South East corner; this tree is in a straight line from the stump afre said with the Sycamore Greek as it comes out of the hills near the head waters thereof - the two. marks mentioned I have Known for the last seven years.
