



A.D. 1835 Jose Castro first member of the Deputation  
and Governor ad interim of the Territory of  
Upper California in the exercise of powers in him  
vested and by virtue of the Leases then in force  
granted to this petitioner a tract of land called  
Elano del Teguasquite situated in what is now  
known as the County of Monterey State of California  
and bounded and described as set forth in  
title papers to said Land a copy of which grant  
is herewith filed marked Exhibit **A**

A translation of the copy referred to is herewith  
filed marked Exhibit **B**

That the said Land contains one and a half  
Leagues more or less, more fully to appear in the  
respective Expedientes.

That this Land has not been surveyed by Surveyor  
General.

That there is no known interfering claim in and  
to the said Land

That this petitioner Jose Maria Sanchez has been  
in the continuous and uninterrupted possession of the  
Land aforesaid

That this petitioner relies on the support of the  
claims herein mentioned upon the papers now  
submitted, the evidence relative to said claim  
existing in the archives of the former Government  
of this Territory now under the charge of the Surveyor  
General and all such other proof as may be  
pertinent to the said claim.

Office of the Board of Commissioners of Land Claims  
San Francisco May 4th 1852

On this day before me "Hilance Hull one of  
the Commissioners for Ascertaining & Settling private  
Land claims in the State of California came  
Fran<sup>c</sup>co Perez Pacheco a witness produced on behalf  
of the claimant Jose Maria Sanchez whose petition  
is Number 133 on the Docket of the Board was  
duly sworn. His evidence being given in the Spanish  
Language was interpreted by the Secretary

The Law Agent was not present and attended  
in answer to questions propounded by the counsel  
for the petitioner the witness testified as follows

My name is Francesco Perez Pacheco, my  
age is fifty nine years I reside in Monterey &  
have resided in California for thirty <sup>two</sup> years  
principally in Monterey

I know that Jose Maria Sanchez soleceted the land  
llano del Tapescito that it was granted I think  
about the year 1836. Immediately after the grant  
was made Sanchez built a house on the land and  
lived in it himself & occupied also with stock  
and by cultivation for raising grain and vegetables  
He has continued to occupy the land to the present  
time. Deed of possession was given him by Rafael  
Gonzales.

I am acquainted with the names writing and  
signatures of Francisco Castillo Negrete Jose Ma  
Castaneda, Jose Rafael Gonzales, Rafael Moter  
Jose Siburcio Castro, Juan Ortega Jose Leon  
Juan Madariaga & Losme Ponce. I have exam  
ined their signatures appearing in several places  
on exhibits & files in this case and have no doubt  
they are genuine. My own signature which also  
appears on these papers is also genuine

In answer to questions put by the Lawyer Agnes the witness  
says that he believes the house was built within a  
year after the grant was made. My signature was  
placed to the paper at the date above that time  
The distance of the Rancho from the Sea Coast in  
a direct line to the nearest point is about 8 leagues  
as I think. The most distant part of the land  
may be eight Leagues and a half from the Coast

The claim of title in favor of Jose Maria Sanchez is sustained by proof of the original grant which was issued to him by Jose Bustillo at that time Political Chief ad interim bearing date the 12th day of October 1835. The approval of the Territorial Deputation was given on the same day and peaceful possession of the premises with a proper description of the boundaries was delivered to the grantee on the 19th day of November 1835. The record of the predecessor possession shows that question arose as to the property of enclosing within the boundaries a piece of land on which are some sulfur springs, it being contended by the neighboring land holders that the right to procure the sulfur or pitch must remain free. Reference of the question was made to the political chief who decided that the right to gather it belonged to the legal possessor of the land and that no other person had a right to enclose that the land on which it found and which was granted to Sanchez should be embraced within the predecessor measurement. On the receipt of this decree the predecessor measurement was complete according to its terms.

By the deposition of Francisco Perez Sanchez it is proved that Secco Sanchez went into possession of the premises immediately after the grant was made.


