Gentlemen:

Each of the persons whose name appears on the list which is annexed hereto and incorporated herein is a native-born American who has had Japanese in his or her ancestral line. Each of said persons for many months has been and now is interned and held under duress at the Tule Lake Center situated at Newell, Modoc County, California, presently being detained there by the Officer In Charge, United States Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service. Each of said persons there is held under a fictitious claim that he or she is an alien enemy and that his or her internment and detention is based upon an asserted claim of color of authority of the Alien Enemy Act, 50 U.S. Code, sec. 21 et seq.


Each of said persons whose name appears on said list of names is a native-born American, a citizen and national of the United States, a person and inhabitant of the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction of the United States. None of them is an alien enemy and none of them at any time whatever has been an alien enemy or an alien or a national of or a citizen of or a subject of any foreign sovereign, government, power or nation.

As the attorney duly authorized to represent and representing each of said persons whose name appears on the said list of names, and for and on behalf of each of them, I hereby withdraw, retract, rescind, revoke, cancel and annul any and all requests, pleas, demands, consents and applications heretofore made by any of them for any repatriation, transfer or deportation to Japan or to any other foreign country, if any such request, plea, demand, consent or application heretofore was made by any of them to you, your office, the United States or any agency or representative thereof, or to any foreign government or any agency or representative thereof, or to any other legal or political entity or person.



This revocation and cancellation of any and all such requests, pleas, demands, consents and applications is made and based upon the facts that if any of the said persons at any time whatever made any such request, plea, demand, consent or application, the same was contrary to his or her will, intent and desire and was made without his or her consent and was exacted from him or her while he or she was held in unlawful confinement in a concentration or internment camp by the United States government and its agents, as the warden, jailor and custodian of said person, and was exacted from him or her while he or she was laboring under governmental duress and was made the unwilling victim of the duress, menace, fraud and the undue influence of pro-Japanese groups and gangs of lawless persons confined to said Center who were permitted to and did establish and maintain a rule of tyranny and terror over such persons and compelled them involuntarily to execute such requests or applications.
